Parent & Caregiver Education

Caregivers will be provided with an introduction to Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) information and strategies. This information lays the ground work for workshops and services. All four modules are currently available online at www.csbd.on.ca/autism.

Follow up Coaching Sessions

Following completion of workshops or parent & caregiver education, participants are able to schedule a follow-up coaching session with a member of our team to discuss what they have learned and receive some brief coaching on implementing strategies in their daily routines.



Brief Targeted Consultation

Parents and caregivers can schedule consults with a member of our team to discuss strategies and tools to address a specific goal area. Parents and Caregivers will leave their appointment with concrete tools and strategies they can implement when they get home.

Please note: we will not be able to address serious or potentially serious challenging behaviour within a consultation appointment as a more thorough assessment and intervention would be required

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Parent Support Discussion Group

Participants will meet with fellow parents to discuss various topics related to their child and their needs. Sessions are facilitated by our Family Support Coordinators, and participants will take the lead on the discussion.



Family Resource Clinic Days

Parents and caregivers can register to attend clinic days targeting topics that are of interest to them. Topics may include, funding, navigating the school system, or make and take materials.

Transition Supports

Parents and caregivers can meet with a member of our team to brainstorm, consult and problem solve at a time of transition in their child's life (transition to school, transition to a new school etc.). Our Family Support Coordinators are also available to support you at planning and transition meetings.



Social Groups

Children and youth of similar age can gather and practice conversing and interacting with one another.
